Materials for Science

- One composition notebook that is **at least 100 pages** (NOT a spiral notebook)

 - Colored pencils
 - Notebook paper (with extra packs at home cause you will run out around November...)

Classroom Expectations

- This is an advanced class. This means that we will go more in-depth with the science topics of the sixth grade curriculum. You will be expected to work to the best of your ability at all times. If you need help, it is up to you to come see me for assistance. I will assist you, however, **YOU WILL NOT BE PLACED IN ANOTHER SCIENCE CLASS AT ANY POINT IN TIME**, even if you are not receiving passing grades. Once again, come see me if you need help or assistance.
- Behavior: You will walk in, immediately take your assigned seat and start on your bell work. I expect you to demonstrate PRIDE behavior when you are in my classroom.
- Respect: No talking when someone else is talking and show respect at all times to all.
- Electronics: Everything that has an on button should be turned off during the school day unless I give you permission to use your phone for something specific (stopwatch, etc.).
- Dress Code: Students should dress in accordance to the Handbook. Basically, anything that is an undergarment should be under something.
- Homework: Students will complete any homework to the best of their ability.
- Late Work: You may turn in any late work up to the end of the quarter, but points will be taken off the grade for it being late. Turn your work in on time!
- Absent Work: Pick up your absent work from the absent folder. If you have any questions about the assignment please come see me and I will explain and help. However, **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO PICK IT UP!!!!** Please let me let me know in advance if you are going to be absent so I can get the assignments to you early.
- Dismissal: The bell does not dismiss you. I will dismiss class when everyone is ready.

SCIENCE SAFETY CONTRACT

Safety is the # 1 priority in our classroom. To ensure a safe learning environment, all students will be instructed in science classroom safety and the student /parent/ guardian safety contract will be signed and filed at school. Students acting in an unsafe manor may be removed from any lab activity for one or more class periods and assigned an alternative learning experience.

- 1) I will act **respectfully and responsibly** at all times in the lab. I understand that horseplay, jokes, and pranks are not appropriate during a science lab.
- 2) I will follow all instructions carefully. If in doubt, I will ask my teacher for assistance **before proceeding with the activity.**
- 3) When I enter the lab, I **will not touch any equipment** until instructed to do so.
- 4) I will **remain at my assigned work area** unless otherwise directed by my teacher. I will not wander around the room, **distracting, discussing or interfering** with the lab of others.
- 5) I will **perform only those activities that have been authorized** by the teacher.
- 6) I will **keep my table, the area around it, and communal areas in the room clean and neat.** Before I leave my lab station for the day, I will **clean up, wash down the work area, and return all materials** to their proper place and I will **wash my hands.**
- 7) I will **wear my safety goggles** whenever asked, especially when we are working with glassware, chemicals or heat. **I understand that there are no exceptions to this rule; if I take my goggles off in the lab room, I will surrender my right to do the lab.**
- 8) I will **never use or handle broken or chipped equipment**, especially glassware.
- 9) I will **secure long hair, baggy clothes, and dangling jewelry** while using any source of fire in a laboratory activity.
- 10) I will **not take anything out of the classroom** without permission from the teacher.

I understand, agree to follow, and accept the consequences for not following all of the safety rules discussed in class and within this contract.
