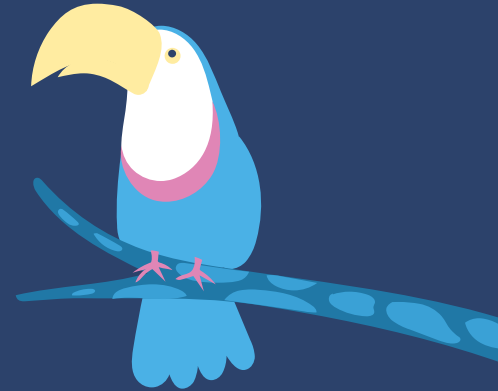



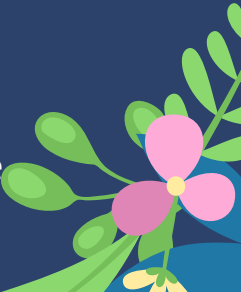

Where you counter your opposition's main points

04

Closing Statement

Restate your main points and position in one sentence

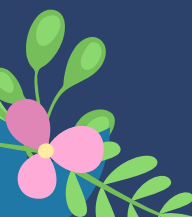
